POINTSCORE SYSTEM (RKA Classes):

0 points system for heats 1 and 2.

Tie in points will be determined as follows:

Rule M.2.28

Winner of a Tie If two (2) or more Competitors have equal points, grid positions or a final placing in any Event, the following process will be used:

a) Equal points for a grid position in a section of an Event, or a final placing in an Event, will be determined by the Competitor with the fastest lap time across all previous Races held during the Event.

Pre-Final and Final

- b) Pre-Final grid determined by points from Heats 1 and 2.
- c) Final grid positions determined by Pre-Final finishing position.
- d) Oceania Series Points awarded to finishers for all races as per point system documented in RKA rules.

RACETRACK ENTRY:

Once Karts start moving and the Out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons, or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts will be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

No dumping of fuel or tyres, please take all used tyres with you.

No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.

No kart engine starts any day before 7.00am or during Drivers Briefing.

Overnight camping is permitted on the grounds.

The Ambulance gate/entrance must be always kept clear.

H. RKA TECHNICAL

3.1 Chassis:

- 3.1.1 Karts homologated or first manufactured in 1999 and before are eligible. And must be approved Kart ID kartid@retrokartingaus.com.au
- 3.1.2 Only one chassis per event is permissible, with the exception that another chassis may be used in exceptional circumstances, e.g., Parts unavailable as a result of a crash, or a broken chassis.
- 3.1.3 Side pods, nose cone and Nassau panel are compulsory.
- 3.1.4 ONLY 17mm front stubs are permissible for competition.
- $3.1.5\,$ All chassis must be identified and passed by RKA prior to use at any RKA event.

3.2 Engines and Chassis:

3.4 Clubman Tyres:

- 3.4.4 MG Red Slick tyres are the only permitted tyres and must be the SH model.
- 3.4.5 Only one set of slick tyres is permitted
- 3.4.6 Only one set of **MG White wet tyres and must be the SW or SW2 model.** If the event is declared "WET" then the MG White wet tyres **may** be used.
